

Turn Problems into Possibilities by Asking Powerful and Generative Questions



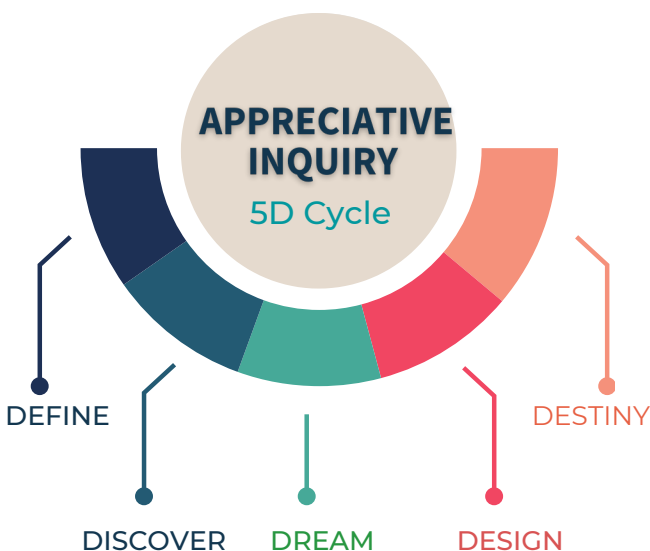
Powerful and generative questions, which start with WHY, HOW, and WHAT and are from one or more of the phases of the 5D Cycle of Appreciative Inquiry.

Step 1: Name the problem or challenge.

Step 2: Pick a generative question or two.

Samples of Generative Questions

DEFINE

- What would I like to grow?
- What do I want to see, hear, feel or do more of?
- What would I like to change?

DISCOVER

- When did I last experience a sense of possibilities and belonging?
- Why is solving this problem important?
- In the last 12 months, what's been my most successful...?

DREAM

- What would I like to see more of?
- What is my greatest hope here?
- If I had a magic wand, how would this challenge look instead?

DESIGN

- What is this problem requiring of me?
- How can I move from here to where I want?
- What is one thing I can do more of, or that I could do differently to move closer to ...?

DESTINY

- What do I need most to overcome?
- What positive habit would I love to adopt?
- What's one thing that I can do right now that would be a game changer?
